In a pioneering effort that seeks to inspire movements toward sustainable peace in South Asia, *Dialogue for Peace Initiatives*, an independent and politically neutral group of students and faculty at Swarthmore College, will host one of the biggest conferences thus far in the United States on the Jammu and Kashmir conflict. *Dialogue for Peace Initiatives: Kashmir* seeks to connect and mobilize involved communities that include the South Asian community residing in the United States, which has the potential to contribute immensely to a peace process in South Asia; the concerned American public; and speakers, who bring with them personal experiences and knowledge about the Kashmir conflict. The three-day-long conference will include a series of panel discussions, community-building workshops, film screenings, and cultural performances.
