

Summer Research Opportunities in Astronomy and Physics at Swarthmore College

Duration:

Normally, 10 weeks (agree with advisor about specific dates)

Funding:

Can come from HHMI, Division, or individual Faculty member grants

To Apply for a place?

Follow these steps:

- A. Be here Feb. 4 and listen to faculty members describe their work
- B. Visit faculty members whose work interests you required
- C. Submit yellow preference sheet to Department Office by Fri. Feb 6.
- D. Hear from prospective advisor(s) on Mon. Feb. 9
- E. Turn in paperwork to your prospective advisor(s) by Thurs. Feb. 12 (use the form at <http://www.swarthmore.edu/x8586.xml>)

What paperwork is required for step E?

- The Swarthmore College "Research Fellowships ..." form with the "Student to Complete" section filled out
- A brief (250 word maximum) description of the research project including goals, where and when it will be done, and how it will benefit your academic program.
- A transcript

Notification

You will hear whether you were indeed funded well before spring break. You will probably hear from your advisor, and will also receive official notification from the Division of Natural Sciences and/or HHMI.
