**Official Course Description:** Statistics 100 introduces the key ideas underlying statistical and quantitative reasoning, including fundamentals of probability. Topics include elements of sample surveys, experimental design and observational studies, descriptive and summary statistics for both measured and counted variables, and statistical inference including estimation and tests of hypotheses as applied to one- and two-sample problems, regression with one or more predictors, correlation, and analysis of variance. The class emphasizes simple and multiple regression and applications in non-experimental fields including, but not limited to, economics.
