Eric Wagner – Co-Director - Swarthmore College Head



Men's Coach. Wagner's Garnet teams have won the ECAC & Centennial Conference titles, and in 2009, they advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA tournament for the 2nd straight time. The Garnet are known for exciting play, as well as for work in the local community to create an atmosphere of social responsibility and cooperation through the world's most

popular game.

Wagner previously coached at St. Mary's College (Md.), where he won more games than any coach in the program's history. In 22 years of coaching, he has appeared at camps and clinics all over the country, including Duke University in NC, Southwestern Univ. (TX), and Notre Dame (IN). He earned the NSCAA Advanced National Diploma and has been a staff coach for Olympic Development Programs in Indiana, Maryland, Texas and Eastern Pennsylvania.

Wagner earned a B.A. in International Relations at Connecticut College, and his M.Ed. from Temple University.

Mike Barr – Co-Director – Director of Coaching, EPYSA,



Mike Barr is one of the most successful coaches in the region. In over 20 years at Strath Haven HS, Barr's teams won 13 Central League titles, 5 District One titles, and 5 PIAA state titles. Many of Coach Barr's players have gone on to play college soccer – at some of the most prestigious colleges and universities in the country.

Barr is currently the Director of Coaching for the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association, and is a National Staff Coach for the United States Soccer Federation & the NSCAA. He is a National Youth License Instructor, and holds the USSF "A" coaching license, the NSCAA International Premier license, the national youth license, and Scottish Football Association's "B" license.

Ciarán Dalton – Swarthmore College Assistant Coach.

Now in his 7th year with the Garnet, Dalton began his soccer career here in Swarthmore. He played at Strath Haven, then moved on to Millersville University. During his career at Millersville, he was named to the All-PSAC 1st team, and All-Region team. He currently ranks 2nd all-time in Millersville history in goals with 43, assists (19), and points (105). Dalton also played for the semi-professional Cobh Ramblers in Ireland.

He was assistant coach at Strath Haven for three years before joining Swarthmore. Dalton has a B.A. in Special Education from Millersville and an M.Ed. from Temple University. He is now in the Doctoral program at Immaculata.
