## Application Information

The purpose of this booklet is to help you to prepare your application to UCT.

Please check that you have:

- an application form for admission to undergraduate or postgraduate study (Form 1)
- a school information form to be completed by all South African school-going applicants (Form 2)
- a personal report form to be completed by all undergraduate applicants to the Faculty of Health Sciences (Form 3)
- details of parents who have studied at UCT (Form 4) — for Alumni Office records

An example of a completed form is given on page 10.

## Dates by which to apply

### Undergraduate Studies

Please submit your application as early as possible. Do not wait until closing date, or until you have received your school-leaving results. Early application will increase your chances of receiving an early provisional offer of admission.

All applications must be received by the following dates:

- **30 September 2007:**  
All international and SADC applicants
- **31 October 2007:**  
All South African applicants

(Please note: Applicants to Health Sciences must apply before they can write the Health Sciences Placement Tests. These tests are written country-wide usually in June and July, which means applicants must apply by the end of April (if they want to write the June HSPT test), and by the end of May (if they want to write the July HSPT test). The final closing date for applications is 31 October. Applicants who have not written the HSPT tests in June or July will have to make their own arrangements with the Health Sciences Consortium to write the tests. See the next section for more information about the tests.)

### Student Housing and Financial Assistance

If you wish to be considered for a place in student housing, and/or if you wish to apply for financial assistance from UCT, the necessary application must reach us by no later than 31 October 2007.

## Admission requirements for undergraduate study

The UCT Undergraduate Prospectus details our minimum admission requirements and additional faculty-specific admission requirements.

**Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission. Places are limited for reasons of capacity and this could mean that applicants who meet the minimum admission requirements, do not receive an offer of a study place.**

**All undergraduate applicants to the Health Sciences Faculty must write the four placement tests offered by The Health Sciences Consortium by July 2007: the Placement Test in English for Educational Purposes (PTEEP), the Mathematics Comprehension Test (MCOM), the Mathematics Achievement Test (MACH), and the Scientific Reasoning Test (SRT). Performance in these tests will be used in addition to school-leaving results and will not replace the use of school performance indicators (including matric points).**

**All undergraduate applicants to the Humanities Faculty, who are normally resident in South Africa, must write the Placement Test in English for Educational Purposes (PTEEP) before being considered for admission in 2008. Performance on this test will be used in addition to school-leaving results and will not replace the use of school performance indicators (including matric points).**

## Funding for undergraduate study

If you are an undergraduate applicant and need funding to enable you to study at UCT, you MUST complete section J of Form 1 and tick the "YES" box.

We do not have sufficient funds to assist all financially needy students. Therefore, you must also apply to other organisations that offer financial assistance to students. A booklet listing many of these organisations is available from the Student Financial Aid Office.

Only South African citizens applying and registering for an approved full-time programme of study are eligible for financial assistance from UCT.

Please send a cheque, draft or postal order. Please do not send cash in the post. Cash payments may be made at the Cashiers Office, Kramer Building. This office is open from Monday to Friday between 9h00 and 15h30, except on Thursdays when it opens at 09h30.

### PLEASE NOTE

- **Application fees are not refundable under any circumstances.**
- Applications submitted without the application fee will not be processed.
- Completion of an application form and payment of an application fee do not mean that you have been or will be offered a place to study at UCT.
- Please enclose the correct application fee with your application form. The application fee must be paid by cheque, bank draft or postal order. Payments must be **made payable to the University of Cape Town** in South African rand.
- Graduates of UCT are exempt from paying the application fee, except in the case of MBA.

## Acceptance Deposits

If we offer you a place at UCT (either an academic place or a place in student housing) you may be asked to pay an acceptance deposit to secure your place. Acceptance deposits will be credited to your student fee account, but will not be refunded at all.

## Application Procedures

On receipt of your application, our Admissions Office will send you an acknowledgement letter. This letter will specify your application number. Please quote this number in all subsequent communication with UCT. The Faculty to which you have applied will assess your application. You will receive correspondence from the:

- Admissions Office acknowledging your application.
- Faculty Office regarding your study programme.

- Faculty Office & Student Financial Aid Office regarding your application for financial aid.
- Student Accommodation Office regarding your housing application.

Once you have your application number, you can check the progress of your application on the UCT website ([www.uct.ac.za](http://www.uct.ac.za)).

## Late submission of supporting documents

We reserve the right to cancel your application if all the necessary supporting documents are not received by **15 January 2008**. Documents include official statements of school results showing matriculation endorsement status and, in the case of transferring students, transcripts of university results and certificates of conduct. For submission of TOEFL or IELTS results, please see the section on English Language Proficiency. (Page 5.)

## Housing Application

If you wish to be considered for student housing in 2008, **please complete the Housing Application section on the application form.**

MBA and AIM applicants must apply direct to the Graduate School of Business for student housing.

UCT has a three-tier residence system that provides different levels of services, governance and management for junior and senior students.

First-tier residences provide accommodation for undergraduate men and women students who are usually under the age of 21. These residences provide students with up to three meals a day in a dining hall. Second-tier catering residences usually provide accommodation for undergraduate students who are usually 21 years or older, for those who are in their third year of study, and for postgraduate students.

Second-tier self-catering residences and flats are usually reserved for postgraduate students, or students who are over 21 or in their third year of study. No food services are provided.

The third-tier provides self-catering accommodation for senior and postgraduate students.

Only students applying for full-time study are considered for UCT accommodation. Priority is given to applicants living outside of the Cape Metropolitan Area, although we try to assist all applicants from historically disadvantaged areas.

Local academically meritorious applicants may be considered for accommodation if capacity allows for this. Details of the different residences and houses in each tier are given on the UCT website. Further residence information is given to successful applicants.

## Tuition Fees and Student Housing Costs

A separate booklet on 2008 fees will be issued in January 2008 to all those applicants who are offered places to study at UCT and will be available on the following website:

Tuition fees cover the full cost of tuition and extra funds will be required to pay for books and travel. Residence fees are made up of room and meal charges (catering residences), or room charges only (self-catering). Extra funds will be required for food in private board and lodging (if not in residence), and in self-catering residences.

### International Postgraduate Applicants

International students, wishing to apply for structured programmes that include coursework, and which would normally commence at the start of the South African academic calendar (as from the month of February of each year) must apply by 30 September 2007.

## Additional information required from applicants for postgraduate studies

You must submit:

- Proof of English Language proficiency (See section on page 5 on English Language proficiency.)
- Original academic transcript covering all periods of registration at every university that you have attended. Any documentation not in English must be translated and sworn to by an authorised translator. You may be required to have your qualifications evaluated by the SAQA Evaluation Centre, Postnet 248, Private Bag X06, Waterkloof, 0145. Tel: (012) 431 5000.
- If you are an applicant for Masters or Doctoral study, a letter indicating either the coursework programme for which you are applying or briefly stating your proposed area of specialisation for research and, if known, the name of your proposed supervisor. (Please refer to the relevant faculty student handbook for more detail. These may be found on the University's website.)
- Applicants for the Postgraduate Diploma in Law, Master of Laws and Master of Philosophy in Laws by coursework applicants to the Faculty of Law, must complete the School for Advanced Legal Studies motivation form. This form will be posted to you on request or can be downloaded from the website: [www.advancedlaw.uct.ac.za](http://www.advancedlaw.uct.ac.za)

## Funding for postgraduate study

If you wish to be considered for funding towards the cost of Honours, Masters or Doctoral study, please note the following:

- While we undertake to assist as many students as possible, financial assistance is not guaranteed.
- All applicants for Honours, Masters and Doctoral studies **must contact** the Postgraduate Funding Office for a funding application form. Alternatively, forms are available via the internet: [www.pgfo.uct.ac.za](http://www.pgfo.uct.ac.za)
- When you return the completed funding application form to the Postgraduate Funding Office please provide:
  - o your intended course of study (degree and department) at UCT;
  - o the names of any awards that you currently hold, if you will be continuing the same course of study.
- The major sources of funding for Honours, Masters and Doctoral study are the MRC (Medical Research Council) and NRF (National Research Foundation). Any candidate for a postgraduate degree who does not apply for the appropriate Research Council

bursary may not be considered for UCT financial assistance.

- You are urged to apply for funding administered independently of the University by writing to donors listed in the booklet *Financial Assistance for Postgraduate Study and Postdoctoral Research*. ## Funding for International Postgraduate Students

Before applying to the Postgraduate Funding Office for funding, you must submit your UCT application (Form 1). Funding application forms must be completed and returned along with the following documentation by 31 July 2007:

- Details of your present course of study as well as those of your intended course of study.
- Curriculum Vitae.
- Details of other funding, or applications for other funding, and/or earnings.

**Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.**

UCT International Student scholarships are NOT full cost awards. You must ensure that you have the balance of funding necessary for your subsistence and personal expenses.

## INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

### International Academic Programmes Office (IAPO)

IAPO's role is to lead the development of internationalisation at UCT by acting as the central coordinator and facilitator of all internationally related initiatives and activities. IAPO provides support to international students and facilitates their integration into the UCT environment. IAPO will help international students with queries relating to application procedures, application deadlines, visa requirements, housing and international tuition fees. Queries relating to academic qualifications and specific course requirements must be directed to the relevant faculty office.

Prospective undergraduate and postgraduate international students who intend to study for a degree at UCT must complete Application Form 1. International students who intend to study at UCT for only one or two semesters, or international students who wish to be affiliated to UCT for short periods, in both cases not obtaining credit towards a South African degree, must complete Application Form 6 obtainable from our International Academic Programmes Office, University of Cape Town, Private Bag X3, Rondebosch, 7701. ### English Language Proficiency

The medium of instruction and examination at UCT is English. We require students to be proficient in English before they register. Applicants for undergraduate and postgraduate programmes must have attained one of the following levels of proficiency in English:

- for South African applicants a pass in an examination equivalent to English (E-symbol) at the Higher Grade (First or Second Language) at the South African senior certificate level. The English requirement in the Faculty of Humanities is a D-symbol (HG).

- for international applicants for whom English is a foreign language: a pass in the TOEFL test (the Test of English as a Foreign Language) with a score of at least 570 on the paper-based TOEFL, or 230 on the computer-based TOEFL test; or an overall band score of 7.0 (with no individual element of the test scoring below 6.0) on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS);
- for applicants who are permanent residents in South Africa and for whom English is a second language: a pass (65% or more) in the Placement Test in English for Educational Purposes (PTEEP) which is conducted by the University, and normally offered in May and September; or a pass in the TOEFL test with a score of at least 570; or an overall band score of 7.0 (with no individual element of the test scoring below 6.0) on the IELTS.

**This is the minimum English language requirement for admission. Individual faculties may have higher English language requirements. Details are given in the *Undergraduate Prospectus* and Faculty handbooks.**

## Study Permits

In terms of the Immigration Act No 13 of 2002, if you are resident outside of South Africa and are not a South African citizen or do not have permanent residence, you are required to obtain a study permit to enter the Republic for the purpose of attending the University.

The offer of a place by the University does not bind the Department of Home Affairs in any way to allow you to reside in South Africa, nor does it remove the need for you to obtain permission to enter the country. If you are offered a study place please apply immediately for a study permit. Your application must be made to the nearest South African Embassy, Consulate or High Commission. This procedure could take up to 8 weeks. The application form BI-1738, duly completed, must be accompanied by the following:

- Valid passport
- A fee (current details are available from the nearest South African Embassy, Consulate or High Commission)
- Confirmation of acceptance by UCT, including accommodation arrangements.
- Proof of sufficient financial means to cover tuition fees, subsistence, incidental costs in the form of a bursary or bank statement
- Proof of repatriation undertaking – usually a cash deposit or bank guaranteed cheque equivalent to the cost of a return ticket to your country of origin or residence; or in the case of African countries only, proof that your country has signed a written undertaking to pay costs for your repatriation should it become necessary
- A medical and radiological report from your doctor indicating general good health (not more than six months old)
- Police clearance certificate (anyone 18 years and older)
- Proof of medical cover with a medical scheme registered in terms of the South African Medical Schemes Act, 1998 (Act no. 131 of 1998) or other medical insurance cover recognized in the republic (for further information on this go to [www.medichalschemes.com](http://www.medichalschemes.com))

All international students are required to report to IAPO with the following before proceeding for registration with their faculty:

- Your study permit valid for studies at UCT
- Proof of payment of tuition fees for the academic year
- Proof of medical health insurance cover

International students residing within South Africa will not be able to register unless in possession of a valid study permit and proof of medical cover. International students (Masters and Doctoral students) living outside South Africa during the academic year may be registered by the University without having to apply for a study permit. Such students need to obtain a suitable visa when visiting UCT and their supervisors, and on arrival in Cape Town they must report to IAPO with details of their visa.

If you purchase a non-South African medical insurance

policy, you may be asked to pay upfront at a South African hospital. You would then have to claim on your policy. Please contact IAPO if you need advice regarding medical policies.

International students from outside the SADC region must pay the full international term fee before registration. The International Academic Programmes Office (IAPO) will send you a fee invoice detailing the cost of your study for the duration of your stay. If you are a student from the SADC member countries\*, you pay the local/South African fee. All non-South African students who qualify for local fee rates must pay the minimum initial payment of academic and residence fees prior to registration.

\*The SADC countries are: Angola, Botswana, Democratic Republic of Congo, Lesotho, Madagascar, Malawi, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia, Swaziland, South Africa, Tanzania, Zambia and Zimbabwe.

Please note that the Registrar may cancel your registration at the end of the first term if you have failed to make these payments, or failed to provide evidence acceptable to the University that a sponsor or bursary organisation will pay the fees for the year, by 15 May. This includes student housing fees if you are to stay in a UCT student residence.

## GENERAL

### • Codes for the Application Form

### • Submit only one application form

We need only one completed Form 1 from you. This allows you to make two choices of study.

### • Certified Copies of Documents

You may be asked to submit specified documents with your application form. Please send copies, and NOT original documents. COPIES MUST BE CERTIFIED by a Commissioner of Oaths. Any School Principal, Postmaster, Police Officer, Advocate or Attorney will certify copies for you. We will retain these copies. We accept no responsibility for any original documents received. Please note that we will not hesitate to prosecute anyone who submits forged documents.

### • Faxed Copies of Form 1 or of Documents

Please note that we DO NOT accept faxed copies of Form 1 or of supporting documents.

If you are currently completing A/AS, HIGCSE, International Baccalaureate or any other foreign school leaving examinations we will require certified copies of prelim and predicted scores for all subjects. Once you have the final results of your school-leaving examination, please send a certified copy to the Admissions Office at UCT by post or courier.

**Please note: candidates who have written only the O-level or equivalent examination and who are not writing any other school-leaving examination are not eligible for admission to this University.**

#### Section F: PAST SENIOR CERTIFICATE OR SCHOOL-LEAVING DETAILS

- Past SA matriculant  
If you have written a SA school-leaving examination, attach a certified copy of your senior certificate to Form 1. If you have written the senior certificate examination more than once, please submit certified copies of all your certificates.
- International Students

#### Matriculation

Matriculation means you have met the legal minimum admission requirement for degree study. This means that:

- your Senior Certificate has been endorsed by UMALUSI to the effect that you have met the minimum requirements for admission to degree study in a South African university; or
- you have a certificate of complete exemption from matriculation endorsement requirements, issued by the Matriculation Board.

**NB. Faculties set additional admission requirements over and above the minimum legal requirement.**

#### Conditional Matriculation Exemption

We do not usually accept applicants with certificates of Conditional Exemption. However, we may give special consideration to applicants who qualify for Conditional Exemption.

These certificates can be granted to:

- South Africans on the grounds of mature age, subject to minimum requirements as set by the Matric Board.
- applicants who have written a school-leaving examination other than the SA Senior Certificate
- immigrants
- applicants who have obtained certain post school qualifications

Where a study place offer is received, it is the applicant's responsibility to apply to the Matriculation Board for the issue of the necessary conditional exemption certificate.

### **FORM 3**

**Personal Report Form for applicants to undergraduate programmes in the Faculty of Health Sciences: This form is only for applicants who are applying for admission to undergraduate study in the Faculty of Health Sciences.**

Academic achievement and performance in the Health Sciences Placement Tests are the most important criteria for a place in the Faculty of Health Sciences, but consideration is also given to your extra-mural activities. We assess these activities from information you supply in the PERSONAL REPORT FORM; it is thus essential that this form is completed in detail.

When you have completed Section A, please deliver or post the form to the Principal of your school (or to a relevant authority if you have already left school), who must verify the information and return the form to the Faculty of Health Sciences. (Refer to address at bottom of Form 3.)

**N.B.** We will not consider your application for admission to the Faculty of Health Sciences without this form. Applicants who are already studying at tertiary level may submit a curriculum vitae instead of the Personal report. This need not be verified, but the CV must contain the names, designations and contact details of at least two referees who would be able to confirm important information in the CV about extra-curricular activities and achievements. **(If you have any questions in this regard contact the Faculty of Health Science Admissions Office at (021) 406-6328.)**
