The Federal Government mandates how we officially report race/ethnicity. However, that is just one way that race/ethnicity can be examined. In this summary, information is presented that details how students are officially reported as well as all of the broad race/ethnicity information that students self-reported on their application to Swarthmore College.

Official Reporting and Self-Identification

Per federal guidelines, students who self-identify as "American Indian/Alaska Native" who **also** self-identify as another race get coded as "two or more races."

Similarly, those who mark Hispanic are coded as "Hispanic" regardless of any other race selection(s). Those who are International get coded as "US Non Resident" regardless of any other race or ethnicity selection.

These visualizations include all students who self-identify as "American Indian/Alaska Native" as all or part of their application race/ethnicity selection while also showing how students are normally reported.

Fall 2023

3% of Swarthmore students enrolled Fall 2023 have self-selected "American Indian/Alaska Native." *However, 0% are reported in that* 25 *category.* The others fall into other reporting categories for the reasons described above.

Of the 45 who selected "American Indian/Alaska Native":

- 7 are counted as "American Indian/Alaska Native"

- 19 are counted as "Hispanic"


- 18 are counted as "Two or more races, non-Hispanic"

- 1 are counted as "US Non Resident"

Only 16% (n=7) of the 45 self-reporting as American Indian/Alaska Native are counted as such.

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Official Reporting and Self-Identification

Per federal guidelines, students who self-identify as Asian who **also** self-identify as another race get coded as "two or more races."

Similarly, those who mark Hispanic are coded as "Hispanic" regardless of any other race selection(s). Those who are International get coded as "US Non Resident" regardless of any other race or ethnicity selection.

These visualizations include all students who self-identify as "Asian" as all or part of their application race/ethnicity selection while also showing how students are normally reported.

Fall 2023

35% of Swarthmore students enrolled Fall 2023 have self-selected "Asian." However, only 18% are reported 300 in that category. The others fall into other reporting categories for the reasons described above.

Of the 606 who selected "Asian":

- 305 are counted as "Asian"
- 7 are counted as "Hispanic"
- 134 are counted as "Two or more races,
- non-Hispanic"



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Official Reporting and Self-Identification

Similarly, those who mark Hispanic are coded as "Hispanic" regardless of any other race selection(s). Those who are International get coded as "US Non Resident" regardless of any other race or ethnicity selection.

These visualizations include all students who self-identify as "Black or African-American" as all or part of their application race/ethnicity selection while also showing how students are normally reported.

Fall 2023

16% of Swarthmore students enrolled Fall 2023 have self-selected "Black or African American." *However, only 9% are reported in that category.* The others fall into other reporting categories for the reasons described above.


Of the 270 who selected "Black or African American":

- 160 are counted as "Black or African American"
- 26 are counted as "Hispanic"
- 47 are counted as "Two or more races, non-Hispanic"
- 37 are counted as "US Non Resident"

Only 59% (n=160) of the 270 self-reporting as Black or African-American are counted as such.


Of the 21 who selected "Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander":

Official Reporting and Self-Selection

On their application to Swarthmore College, prospective students are asked **two broad questions about their Ethnicity and Race**. They are first asked to identify whether or not they are Hispanic or Latino, and then are asked to select one or more of the following five racial categories: American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian, Black or African American, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, and/or White.

Per federal guidelines, students who check "White" and who also check any other race(s) must be included in the "Two or more races" category. Similarly, those who mark Hispanic are coded as "Hispanic" regardless of any other race selection(s). Those who have International Citizenship get coded as "US Non Resident" regardless of any other race or ethnicity selection.

These visualizations include all students who selected "White" as all or part of their application race/ethnicity selection while also showing how students are normally reported.

Fall 2023


50% of Swarthmore students enrolled Fall 2023 have self-selected "White." *However, only 30% are reported in that category.* The others fall into other reporting categories for the reasons described above.

Of the 868 who selected "White":

- 517 are counted as " White"
- 153 are counted as "Hispanic"
- 171 are counted as "Two or more races, non-Hispanic"
- 27 are counted as "US Non Resident"

Only 60% (n=517) of the 868 self-reporting as White are counted as such.
