







Number of Degrees (BA + BS)





Percent of graduates earning double majors







Percent of Graduates by Gender





Percent of Graduates Studying Abroad: Graduates are counted here if they studied abroad through Swarthmore for a semester or year. Data is available from 2004 on.






Number of Swarthmore Honors Graduates by Level of Honors






Number of 2021 MAJORS by Gender


Number of 2021 MAJORS by Gender

Special Majors




Number of 2021 MAJORS by Honors/Course
