Dear Miss Richardson

I confess I am a good deal interested in the suggestion you advanced with regard to the Peace Advocate. I fear to come to a decision just now either way; but will say that the necessity of a general organ of the League movement is more and more impressed upon my mind. I think a publication of the size of the Advocate would be just the thing. But I suppose you do not intend to leave it until the end of the present year, or volume. If so, before that time things might open to make its conversion highly practicable. I am sorry however that you propose to withdraw from the active advocacy you have given to the cause of peace through your interesting monthly.
