## FLORIADE'S "GREEN CITY" OF ALMERE

Floriade 2022 is an extraordinary showcase of the best truly unique flora, horticulture and "green growing city" inspirations that Dutch national growers and horticultural experts from countries around the world offer. A short drive from Amsterdam, Almere is the Netherlands' youngest city and will be the 2022 venue of the international exposition that is held only once every 10 years. Built in Flavoland province, along almost 25 miles of Holland's coastline, Almere's center is uniquely noted for its green architecture. Almere is also a man-made nature reserve dedicated to lakes, forests, beaches and home to rare bird species such as the white-tailed eagle and wildlife including foxes and deer. You will see firsthand how a 21<sup>st</sup> century "green" city is livable and further inspires the four themes of Floriade 2022—"greening the city, feeding the city, healthifying the city and energizing the city." Walk through Floriade's specially created Arboretum, a living library of 3,000 species of trees, shrubs, plants and flowers alphabetically arranged by botanical name and an unforgettable pageant of color and scent. A spectacular nearly 2,700 foot cable ride will provide breathtaking views of Floriade Park and the skyline of Almere. Floriade is a once-in-a-lifetime experience of the best of the international horticultural world.
