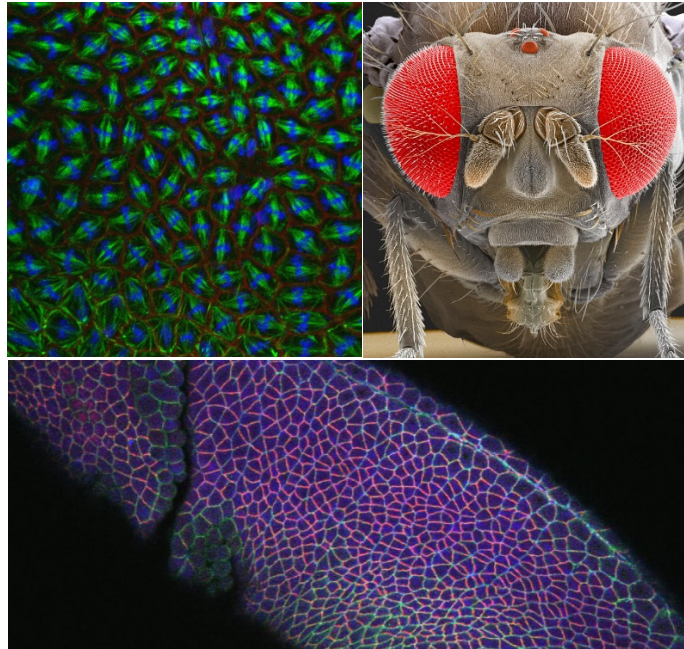


Postbac Lab Technicians Wanted
