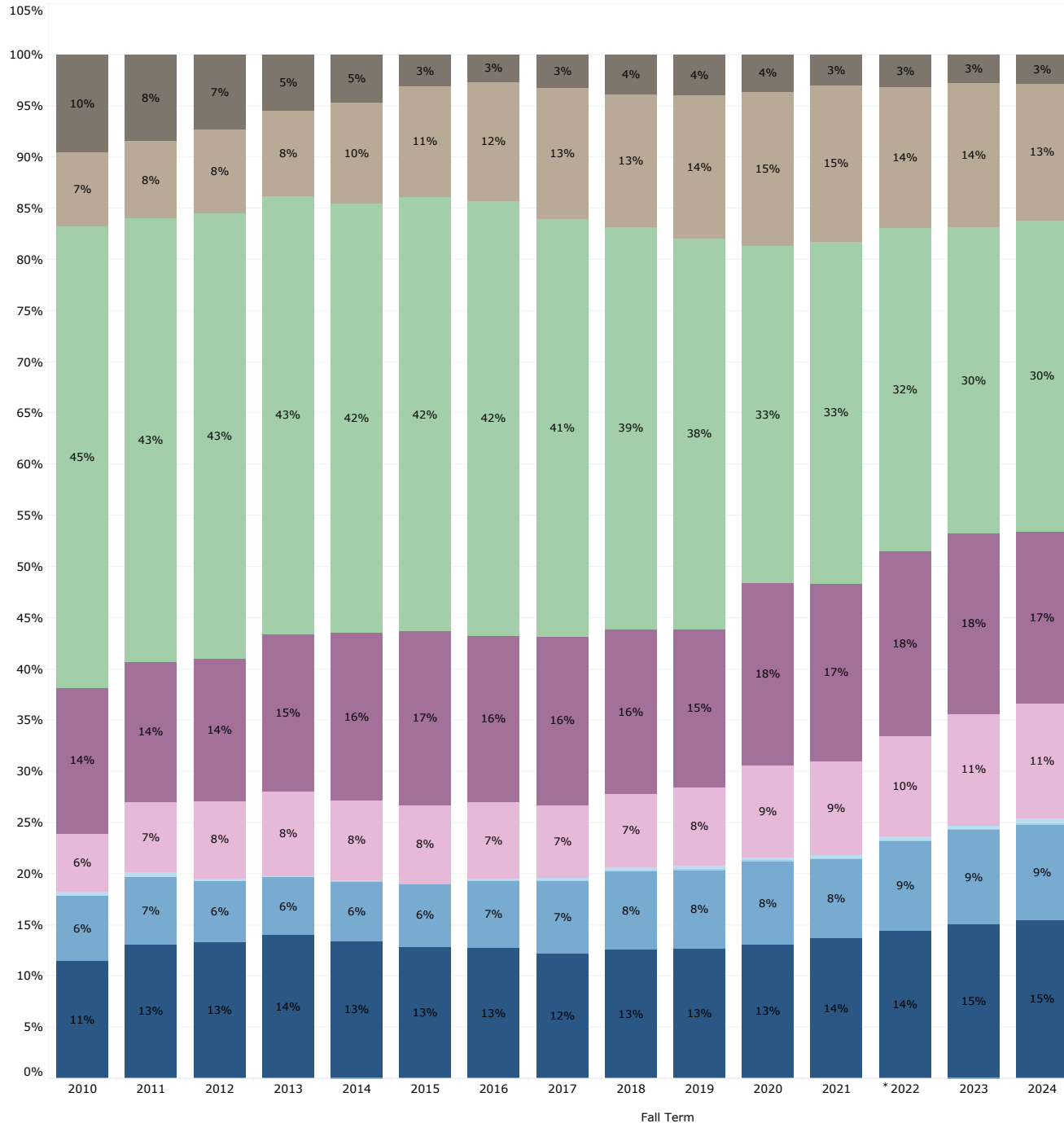


## Swarthmore College Race/Ethnicities of Enrolled Students



**NOTES:**

-In 2010, the federal government mandated new collection and reporting methods for race and ethnicity. All enrollments are presented using the newer coding.

In this newer coding, any student who identifies as **Hispanic** is considered to be Hispanic (even if other races are also selected).

Those who select two or more races (and who do not select Hispanic) are considered to be "**Two or more races**" students.

International Students are considered to be "**US Non Resident**" regardless of what race/ethnicity they selected

-Students studying abroad are included. (See table "Fall Enrollment by Student Category: On Campus and Study Abroad")

- Unknown Race and/or Ethnicity
- US Non Resident
- White, non-Hispanic
- Asian, non-Hispanic
- Two or More Races, non-Hispanic

- Black or African American, non-Hispanic
- Hispanic of any race
