- AP/IB placement can count as 1 course. Note that AP/IB does not receive Swarthmore course credit

Your plan for a psychology program may be deferred but we will re-review your application and approve it once the acceptance criteria are met. Please note that acceptance into your desired program is entirely dependent upon the submission of a completed and departmentally compliant sophomore plan.
