- Completed at least 2 credits in Psychology
- Be in good standing at the College
- Have a B+ or higher averages in Psychology and Overall
- AP/IB placement can count as 1 course. Note that AP/IB does not receive Swarthmore course credit

If you don't meet the criteria yet, you still need to submit a sophomore plan. Your plan for a psychology program may be deferred but we will re-review your application and approve it once the acceptance criteria are met. Please note that acceptance into your desired program is entirely dependent upon the submission of a completed and departmentally compliant sophomore plan.

- 2 Seminars (those with numbers in 130s) that follow up on core courses
- 2-credit thesis (PSYC 180)
- 8 total credits in Psychology (not including AP/IB or STAT 011)
