Acceptance Criteria.

- Completed at least 2 credits in Psychology
- Be in good standing at the College
- Have a B+ or higher average in Psychology
- AP/IB placement can count as 1 course. Note that AP/IB does not receive Swarthmore course credit

If you don't meet the criteria yet, you still need to submit a sophomore plan. Your plan for the psychology program may be deferred but we will re-review your application and approve it once the acceptance criteria are met. Please note that acceptance into your desired program is entirely dependent upon the submission of a completed and departmentally compliant sophomore plan.

- PSYC 001. Introduction to Psychology (or equivalent: AP 5 in Psychology, IB 6 or 7 in Psychology)
- At least 2 Core Courses (those with numbers in 30s)
- 1 Seminar (those with numbers in 130s) that follows up on core courses
- PSYC 025: Research Design and Analysis
- STAT 011 Statistical Methods (or equivalent, e.g., ECON 31) taken before or concurrently with PSYC 025
- At least 5 total credits in Psychology (not including AP/IB or STAT 011); all must be taken at Swarthmore
