

NIH PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR ASSURANCE CERTIFICATION FORM

On April 7, 2006, the National Institutes of Health (NIH) announced a change in business process to replace the Principal Investigator signature on grant applications, progress reports, and prior approval requests with a new institutional compliance requirement to secure and retain the PI signature as part of the institutional review/approval process. The institution must secure the form prior to the institution submitting an application to the NIH. In all cases, this assurance must be available to the sponsoring agency or other authorized HHS or Federal officials upon request.
